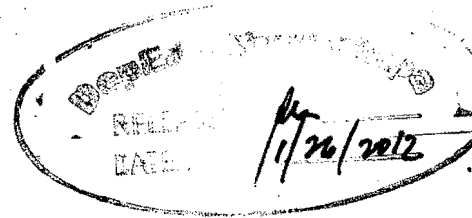

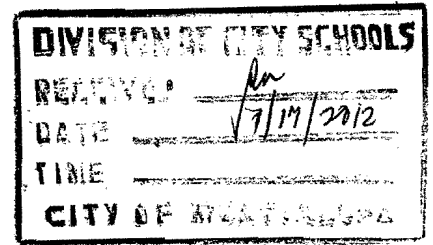

QUIZ BEE COMPETITION

GENERAL MECHANICS

1. Each team is composed of two legitimate 4th year high school student and one alternate.
2. The contest will be divided into three (3) rounds: Easy, Average and Difficult.
3. Questions will comprise Algebra, Trigonometry, Geometry (Plane, Solid, and Analytic), Elementary Statistics, Physics and General Information.
4. No calculators shall be allowed during the entire contest.
5. The contestant should be at the competition venue 30 minutes before the scheduled time. Immediate default will be meted out to the contestants who fail to show up in 15 minutes before the supposed start of the competition.
6. A more detailed set of rules shall be announced before the start of the competition.
7. Prizes for the winners are:

Champion – Scholarship for BS course, Gold medal, Certificate and Cash prize

1st runner up – Cash prize, Silver Medal, and Certificate

2nd runner up – Cash prize, Bronze Medal, and Certificate

- All participating schools shall receive Certificate of Participation

GROUP DANCE CONTEST

MECHANICS

1. The interested group of 4th year high school students shall join the competition through accomplishing prescribed application form.
2. The group should consist of five (5) members.
3. The members of the group shall be a combination of male and female.
4. The accomplished application form shall be submitted or sent to West Bay College at the address stated in the letter or can be sent through email liza_westbay2011@yahoo.com. on or before January 20, 2012.
5. Competition shall be limited to modern dance and the duration of dance execution shall be from four (4) to five (5) minutes.
6. The music shall be provided by the participating group in CD duly labeled in their name & school to the WBC Coordinating Committee, 30 minutes before the start of the contest.
7. The principal or any designated school authority shall sign the approval of their participation in the prescribed application form.
8. All participating dance group shall be at the venue thirty (30) minutes before the start of the competition.

Criteria for Judging:

- Choreography & Creativity (Originality, Concept, Formation & Costume) 40%
- Coordination (Group Synchronization, Dancing style etc.) 25%
- Execution (Showmanship, facial expression & poise) 20%
- Audience Impact (Appeal to audience) 15%

PRIZES:

The winning groups shall receive the ff:

1st Place – 5 Mobile Phones and Certificate

2nd Place - P2,500 Cellphone Loads and Certificate

3rd Place - P1,500 Cellphone Loads and Certificate

ON THE SPOT POSTER MAKING CONTEST

MECHANICS

1. The contest is open to all high school students.
2. Interested student shall register to their respective principal or at the Foundation Committee at West Bay College on the 1st day, Feb. 24, 2012 until 1:00pm.
3. The school principal may submit more than one representative to the competition. Names shall be forwarded to WBC on or before the confirmation date.
4. Participating student shall bring their choice of materials for the contest (oil, pastel, charcoal, water color, crayon etc.). Illustration board shall be provided by the WBC committee.
5. The contest shall be for the duration of one hour.
6. The committee shall give other details of the mechanics on the actual time of the competition.
7. Participants must be at the competition venue thirty (30) minutes before the actual competition.

CHEER DANCING COMPETITION

MECHANICS

1. The group shall be composed of fifteen (15) to twenty five (25) students.
2. Each participating group shall have a minimum of five (5) to a maximum of seven (7) minutes execution
3. The participating group shall provide their music in CD format and should be submitted to the WBC Committee on the date of confirmation or at the latest February 15, 2012.
4. Only up to second level of lifting shall be allowed and strictly no flying stunts in the routine.
5. Costume must not be vulgar or rude (indecent)
6. Props should be limited hand-held, heavy props are not allowed.
7. The participating group must be at the venue of the competition a hour before the start of the competition.

Note: The use of personal protective gadget (knee-pad or elbow caps etc.) is encouraged.
