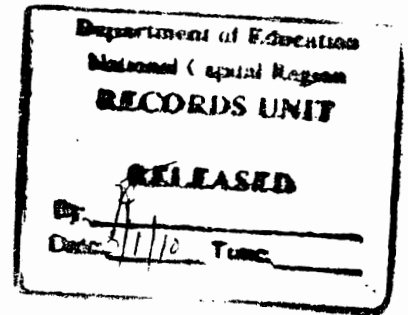

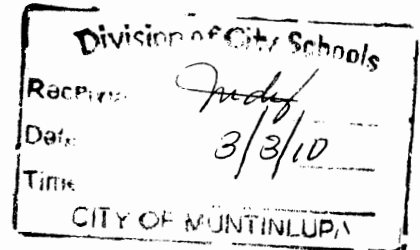

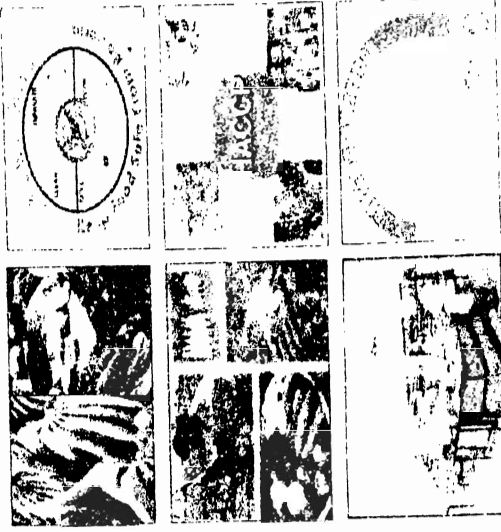

## Rationale

Consumers all over the world are becoming increasingly concerned about the safety of food. Recent cases of food poisoning and food borne diseases have added to these. Globally, people are not only demanding more food, but also a safe supply of food.



In recent years, outbreaks of food-borne diseases (FBDs) and food poisoning have increased alarmingly and at times have resulted in loss of lives (DOH, 2005).



With this increasing incidence of food borne illness, food safety has become a relevant issue as it draws a significant impact on health

Hence, to avoid the occurrence of FBDs and food poisoning, this course on

food safety which follows the WHO-ICD-SEAMEO module will equip the participants with the concepts and principles of food safety: the hazards in food and drink; its etiology, health and nutrition implications, prevention and control, which they can apply in their workplace.
