CONSTITUTING OF SCHOOL DENGUE TASK FORCE AND THEIR FUNCTIONS

1. In order to develop appropriate and effective strategies for the identification of Dengue, including the monitoring and ocular inspection/ of the sites of dengue, the schools is hereto required to organize Dengue Task Force and are expected to perform the following functions.

1. Conduct classroom information campaign.
2. Initiates source reduction within the school premises.
3. Distributes information, education campaign materials and collateral on
 - a. Dengue as a disease
 - b. Aedes, the vector and its life cycle
 - c. Prevention and Control of Dengue
4. Conducts ovil larvi trapping within the school premises.
5. Search for mature larvae and pupaela major containers
