**“INTER-SCHOOLS COMPETITION ON MENTAL  
MATH LOGIC GAMES”**

To: Division Supervisors/Coordinators  
Public/Private Elementary, Secondary School Principals  
Department Heads/Coordinators/Math Teachers

1. The Math and Science Young Adventures Club is inviting students to participate, re **“Inter-schools Competition on Mental Math Logic Games”** featuring *Sudoku, Rubics Cube, Kakuro and Tower of Hanoi*.


2. Prior to this event, Math and Science Young Adventurer’s Club (MSYAC) will conduct first a “School-to-School” - a “Live Campus Training Workshop” to prepare the school kids to the above four (4) game-categories. This school training commences this August and culminates on December, 2010. The said training workshop will be held only during clubbing time or special activity which will consume (1) one and half hour just “one time – one school basis only”.

All Schools that adopted the Live Training Workshop will enjoy the following:

- a. Each participant will receive the training certificate and workshop-hand-out material.
  - b. Since training will focus only on Kakuro (brother of Sudoku) and Tower of Hanoi, the participant should choose either of the two events, only one event at a time.
  - c. Free one set of Tower of Hanoi ( a school must have its own set for on-going practice after the training workshop).
  - d. Free (1) one CD. A visual presentation of Kakuro and Tower of Hanoi (the school may be able to use it for future activity).
3. Participants must reach 100 or more per event per group combination per school only.
4. Group combination are the following:
- Elementary Category
    - a. Primary Group – grade III and IV pupils
    - b. Intermediate Group – grade V and VI pupils
  - Secondary Category
    - c. Junior Group – 1<sup>st</sup> yr and 2<sup>nd</sup> yr student
    - d. Senior Group – 3<sup>rd</sup> yr and 4<sup>th</sup> yr student
5. After the training, the said school is now an official participant to the Annual 2010 Mental Math Logic Games to be held at SM Activity Center, SM North Edsa, Quezon City on January 24, 2011, Morning Session (10-12a.m.) shall be devoted to the elementary participants and afternoon session (1-3p.m.) for the Secondary participant. Winners shall be recognized immediately in the afternoon with cash prizes, medals, school plaque and members certificate. The winners will receive an award. Mental Math Logic Games of the Year.

This is a first come first serve basis only for reservation since limited workshop school slot is available.
